I am taking the liberty to copy a number of stakeholders, that are directly, or indirectly involved in planning and infrastructure development in both the John Taolo Gaetsewe District and Local Municipalities, as well Northern Cape Province.

My provisional comments are as follows:

1. Any high capacity line through and from the John Taolo Gaetsewe District must align with Provincial, District, and Local SDFs, as well as the District One Plan, Rural Development Sector Plan, IDPs, and make provision for, among others:
  - a. Key catalytic programmes and/or projects in order to ignite and diversify the district economy through industrial development, manufacturing, construction, agricultural development, transportation development and knowledge-based economic development.
  - b. Some of the catalytic initiatives are as follows, but not limited to:
    - i. Gamagara LM: Kathu Industrial Park, Iron Smelter, Integrated Human Settlement Development (e.g., 5 700 mixed development, and social facilities such as schools, clinics, etc.), upgrading of Sishen Airport.
    - ii. Joe Morolong LM: Sinter Plant/s, Integrated Human Settlement Development
    - iii. Ga-Segonyana LM: Regional Airport, Regional Hospital, Agri-hub and Park, Light Industry Development, Tertiary Education and Skills Development Facilities (e.g. university, university of technology, TVET and artisan training facilities), Kuruman as Regional Development Anchor on the N14 Development Corridor, Disaster Centre, Sports Stadium, Office Complex/Park, and Heritage Resource Center.
    - iv. District linkage to the Boegoe Bay Deep Water Port and Green Hydrogen Development, Aggenys SEZ, through the Transnet Railway development between the district and the port.
    - v. Alternative energy projects to feed into the national grid and across the district boundaries and border to neighbouring countries and the rest of the SADEC.
    - vi. Gamagara mining corridor development

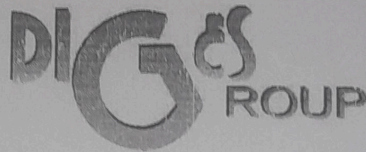

Vhubvo Consultancy cc submitted an application to SAHRA for commenting in terms of section 38 (8) of the NHRA of 1999 no. 25 for the proposed Kimberley Phase 3: Construction of 400kV Ferrum-Mookodi Powerline and associated Substation Upgrade within Joe Morolong, Gamagara, Ga-Segonyana Local Municipalities under John Taolo Gatsewe District Municipality, Northern Cape Province and Naledi, Greater Taung Local Municipalities under Dr Ruth Segomotsi Mompotsi District Municipality, North West Province.

A Background Information Document (BID) was submitted in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, Act 107 of 1998 (NEMA) and the NEMA EIA Regulations (As amended). The proposed project entails: (i) Construct a  $\pm 200$ km, 400kV transmission powerline from Hotazel Transmission Substation to Mookodi Substation. (ii) Construct a  $\pm 60$ km, 400kV transmission powerline from Ferrum Substation to Hotazel Transmission Substation. (iii) Upgrade the Mookodi Substation by installing: 1 X 100MVAR busbar reactor at Mookodi 400kV busbar; 1x400kV Mookodi feeder bay; 1X400kV Line reactor at Mookodi 400kV. (iv) Upgrade the Ferrum Substation by installing, 1 X 100MVAR busbar reactor at Ferrum 400kV busbar; 1x400kV Ferrum feeder bay; and 1X400kV Line reactor at Ferrum 400kV.

### Interim Comment

SAHRA requests that an assessment of the impacts to heritage resources that complies with section 38(3) of the NHRA as required by section 38(8) of the NHRA and section 24(4)b(iii) of NEMA be conducted as part of the EA process.

The assessment must include an assessment of the impact to archaeological and palaeontological resources. The field-based assessment of archaeological resources must be conducted by a qualified archaeologist and the report comply with the SAHRA 2007 Minimum Standards: Archaeological and Palaeontological Components of Impact Assessment Reports (see [www.asapa.co.za](http://www.asapa.co.za) or [www.aphp.org.za](http://www.aphp.org.za) for a list of qualified
